

## Guide to using Cascando OFML data in pCon.planner

This guide will inform you step-by-step about using Cascando OFML data in pCon.planner.

### 1. Opening Cascando products in pCon.planner

Open Cascando products in pCon.planner by clicking on *Products* in the menu bar.

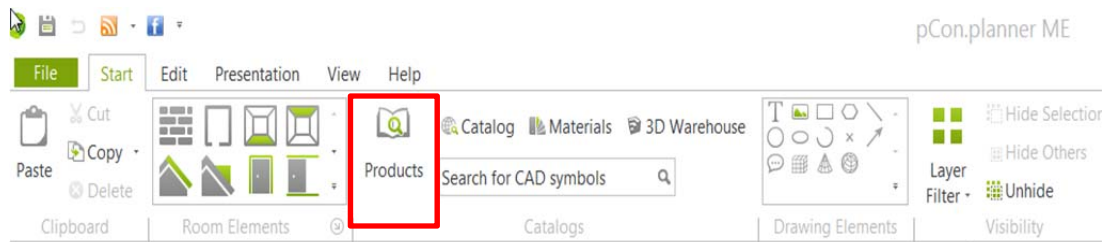

An overview of all available Cascando products appears.

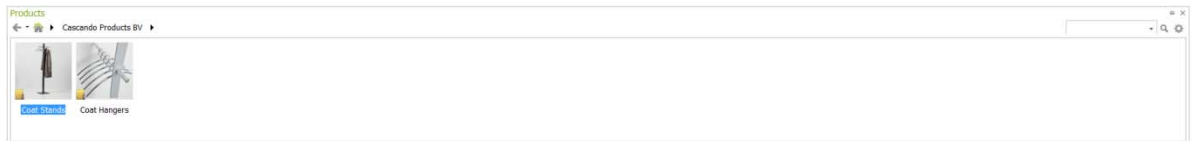

Select a product category and an overview appears of all the products within the selected category.

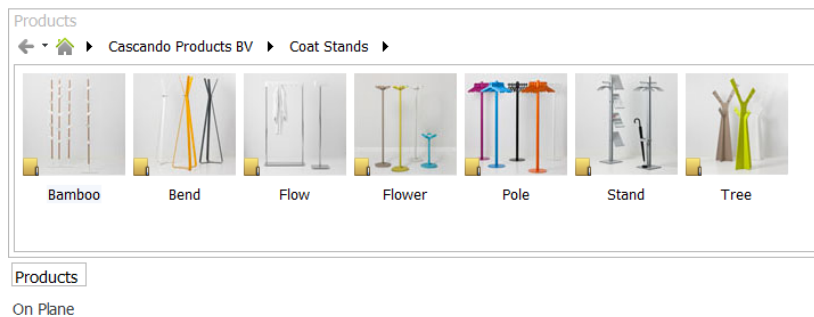

Select the desired product and drag it to one of the four empty boxes on the screen. You can now choose the position of the product.

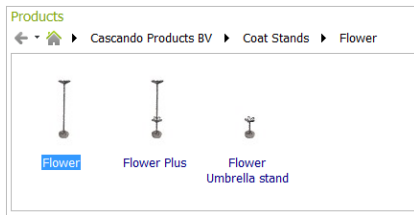

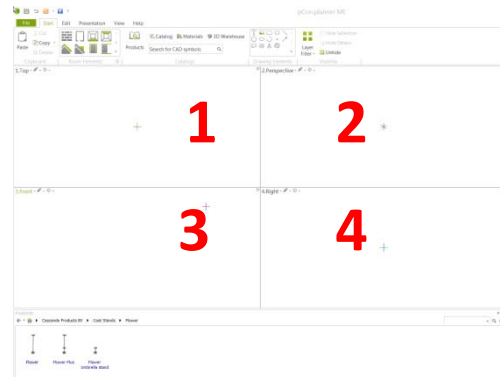

## 2. Configuring products

To configure open products in pCon.planner, the cursor must be positioned over the product. A hammer now appears in the top right-hand corner (see figure 6). Click on this. A menu appears (see figure 7) containing options from which you can make a selection. In the example shown these are Type and Color. If you click on Type, you can change the open product to any other type of coat stand from the Cascando catalogue (see figure 8). The article number and price of the product are shown at the top of the configuration menu.

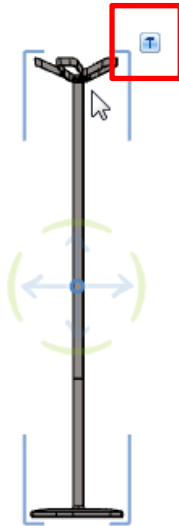

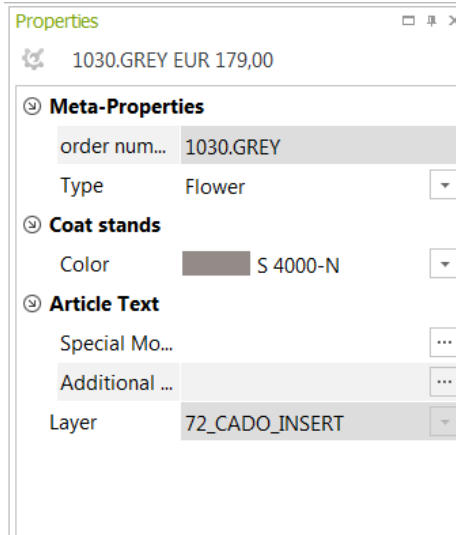

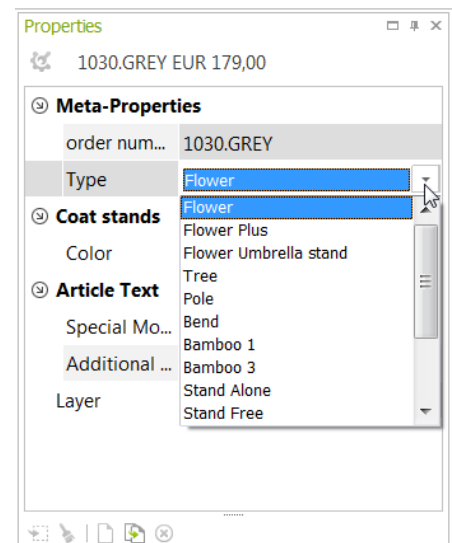

### 3. Saving or printing commercial information

Once the product is exactly as required, you can print out the commercial information. You can also do this for several products simultaneously, e.g. different products in a room, by clicking on the icon in figure 9 (see right-hand bar in pCon.planner). A menu appears (see figure 10). Click on Article List.

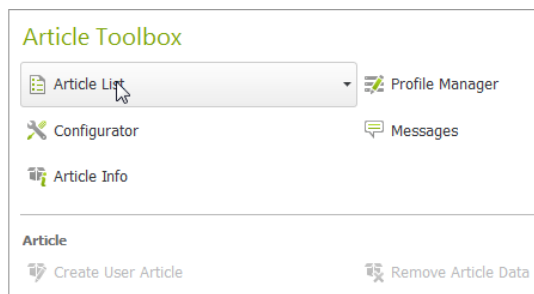

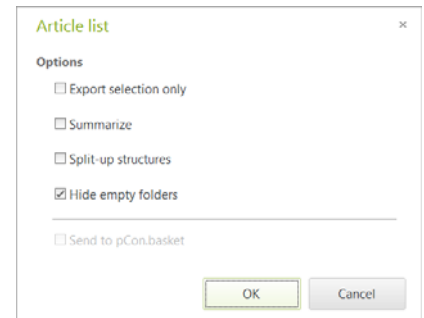

A new pop-up menu appears (figure 11). Select *Export selection only* if you only require the information for the selected product. Then click on OK, or click directly on OK if you need the commercial information for all open products.

A screen now appears showing the commercial information for the product (see figure 12). This list can be printed or exported. If you select Article list, Export, CVS Export, the file is converted into an Excel file. This is useful if you need to add any additional text.

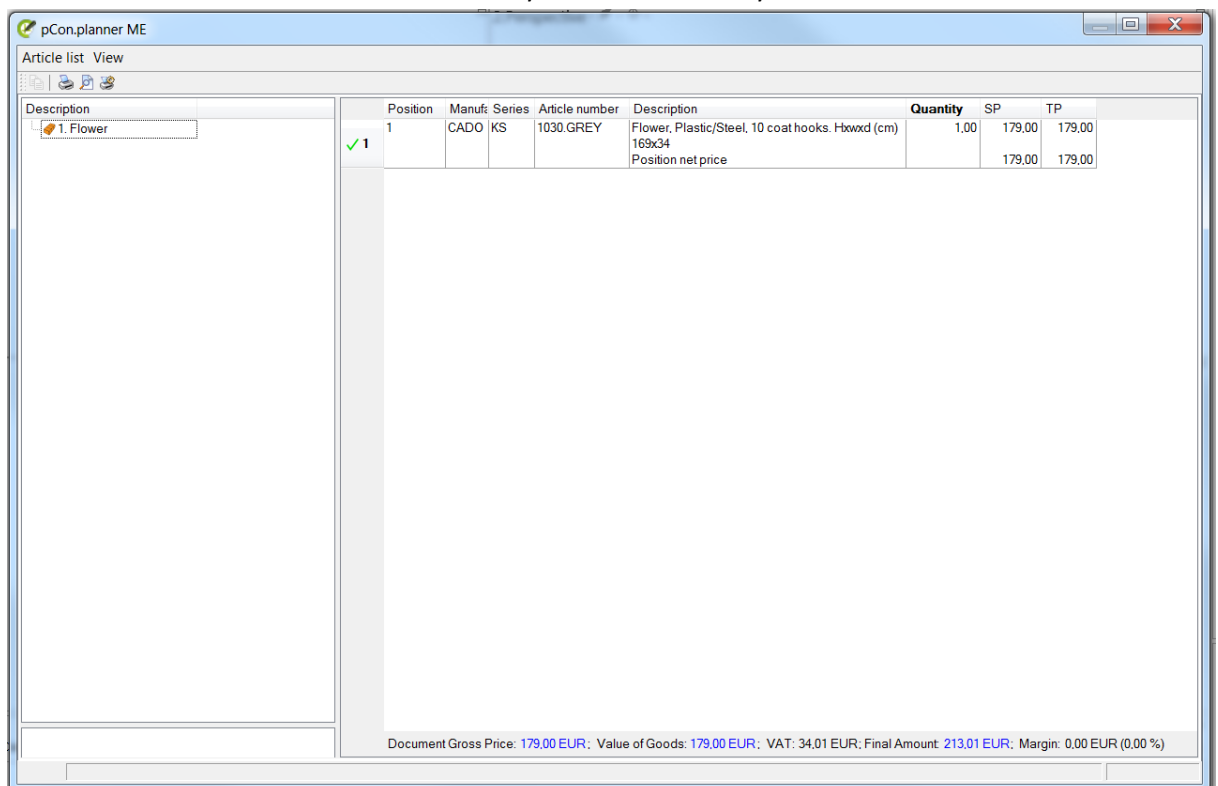

#### 4. Rendering the product

Once the product has been configured in accordance with the customer's wishes, you can render it here. Select the view to be rendered by clicking on the box (top, front, perspective or right view) with your mouse. Make sure the product is in the desired position. Then go to the *Presentation* tab (see figure 13) and click on *Image*. A pop-up screen appears where you can select the size and resolution of the image. Click on the Play symbol to start the

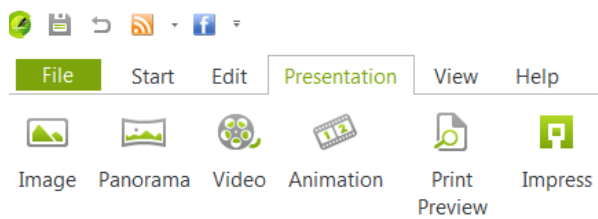

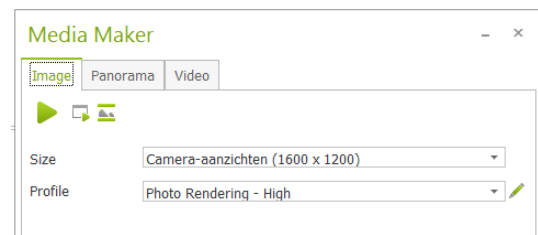

rendering process. Once rendering is complete you can choose to add a logo. Choose the Cascando logo and/or the customer's logo, for example (figure 15). You can do this by clicking on *Logo* and then selecting a jpeg file.

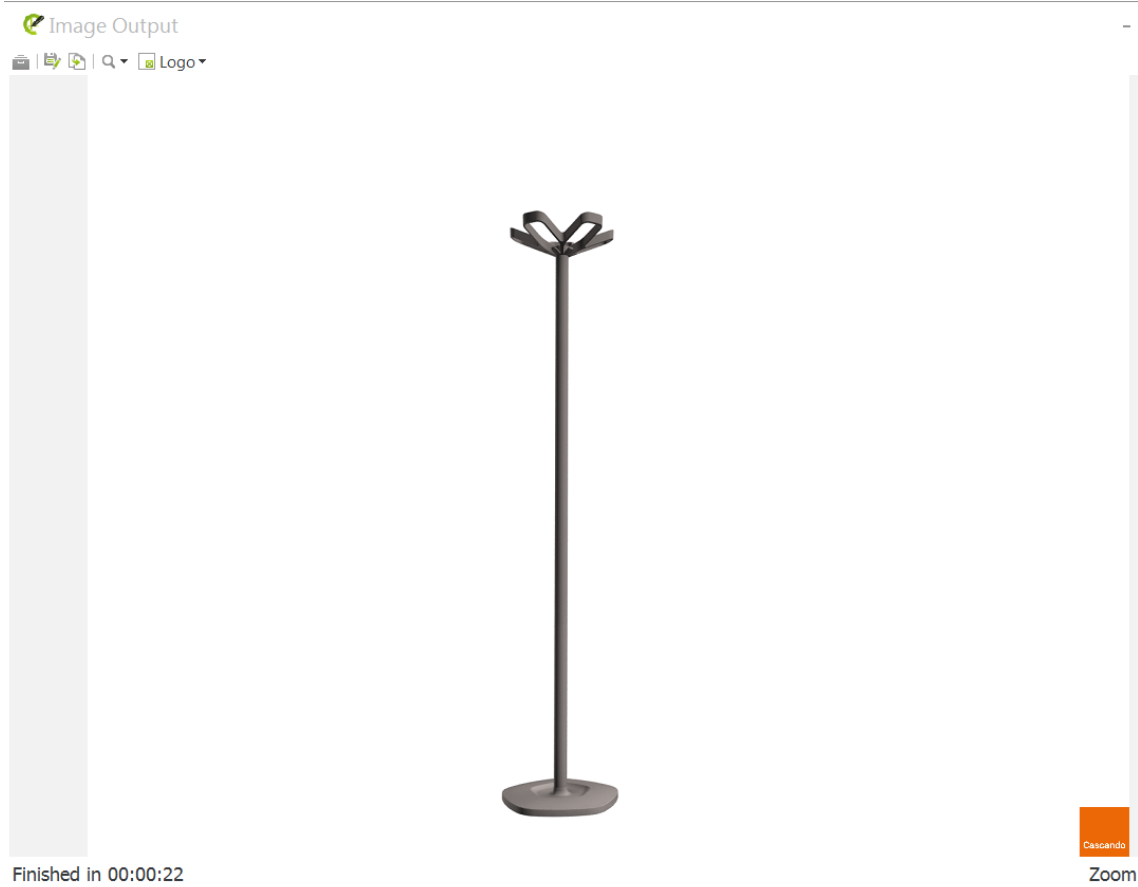

### 5. Updating the product catalogue

When new Cascando products become available they are not immediately included in the catalogue. You need to update the catalogue manually. The product catalogue is updated with the help of the *DataClient* program.

### 6. Importing products

In addition to the products contained in the catalogue, it is also possible to open other products in pCon.planner. pCon.planner is able to open DWG and SAT files. Please note, however, that these products do not contain any commercial information and cannot be configured. Import a product to render it or add it to a room, for example. To import a product, go to the File tab and click on Import (see figure 16). Then select the desired product.

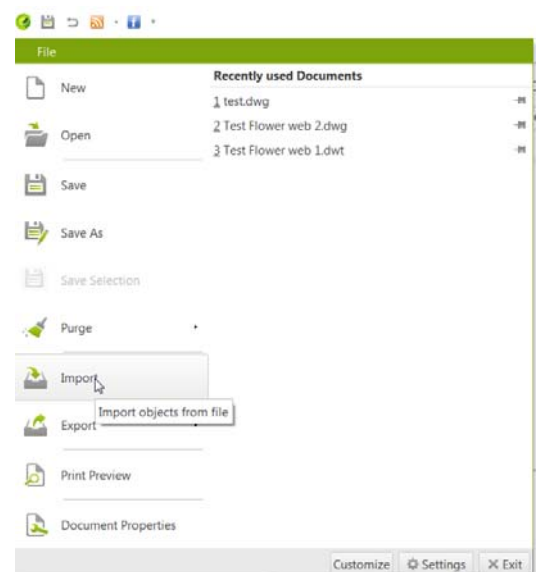
